2. Maintain all setbacks as indicated: 100 feet from shared & saprolite systems, 50 feet from non-saprolite systems, 25 feet from buildings/decks/outbuildings, 25 feet from stream &/or springheads, 50 feet from ponds.
3. Construct well in area indicated on the site plan.
4. **Do not install in any powerline rights-of-way or road easements (owner and driller to confirm ROW's, easement locations AND property lines prior to drilling).**
5. **Well construction must comply with all other criteria and standards set forth in 15A NCAC 18A .1700 (Well Construction Standards).**

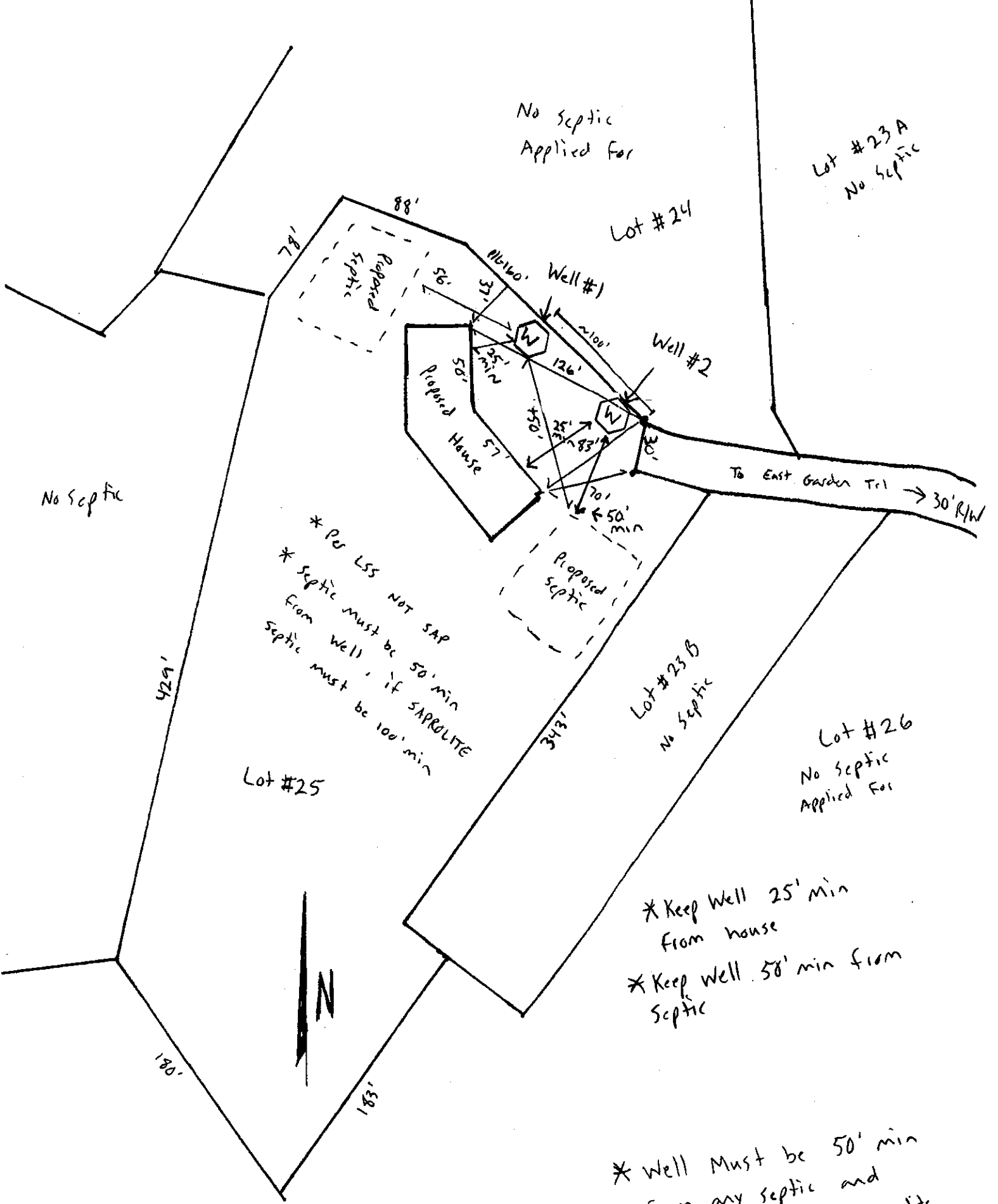
Permit valid for 5 years provided site conditions do not change.

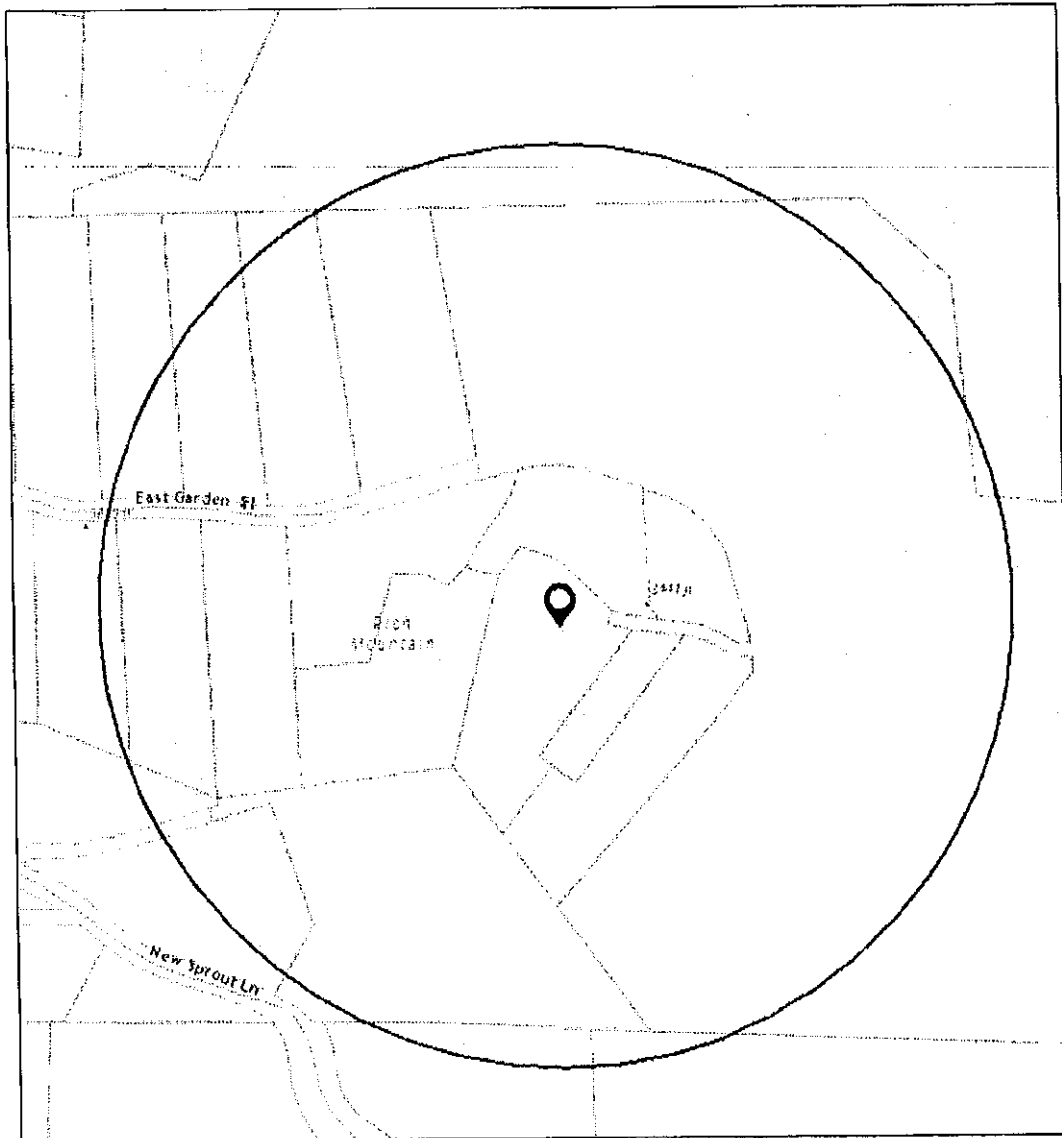

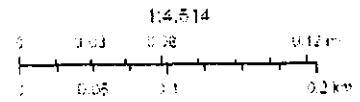
